


# Biometric Recognition Safe Locking System

# MANAGER OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

#### SMARTPOINT/SMARTLINC II

This system is available with or without biometric identification ability. If using the SMARTLINC II, without biometric feature, please disregard any reference, in these instructions, to fingerprints. The functionality of the two systems are identical except for the use of fingerprints for identification.

# **AUDIT**

 Each lock will record last 4000 events. Logic Module can scroll last 1000 system events (all locks and users)

## **DUAL CODE**

· Requires the presence of two users to open.

#### WRONG TRY PENALTY

Four (4) consecutive invalid codes initiates five-minute delay period.
 Two additional invalid codes will begin another five-minute delay.

#### LOW BATTERY WARNING

 Repeated audio and visual signal (LCD readout and repeated beeping) during opening indicates back-up battery is low and should be replaced.

#### **AUDIO AND VISUAL SIGNAL**

- Double signal (LCD readout and unit beeps) indicates entry is valid or accepted
- Triple signal indicates invalid or not accepted

## TIME LOCK

- Two Time Lock periods are available for set-up
- Selectable for each lock Time Lock 1, 2 or None
- Standard Week (Up to 4 open periods per day)
- Special Events (Up to 20 close periods programmable by day and month) [i.e., January 1, July 4]
- Immediate Time Lock (From now until next available open period)
- Time Lock Open Period Extension (Max. two [2] hours), if enabled.

The SMARTPOINT is a feature-rich product with many possible options. Please read through the instructions carefully before attempting any programming. After reading through the entire manual, highlight any features to be programmed in the system.

#### 1.0 CHANGING YOUR CODE - MANAGER

## ALWAYS PERFORM THIS OPERATION WITH THE DOOR OPEN

- 1. Press any key to power up SMARTPOINT.
  - Display will show either "ENTER CODE" or SELECT LOCK" when two or more locks are installed.
- 2. Select lock if two or more locks are installed.
- 3. Enter "zero" six times
- 4. Enter existing six (6) digit code one time.
- 5. Enter NEW six (6) digit code two times (and scan finger, if set-up, after 2nd entry).
  - If a valid code is entered, display will show "CODE CHANGED"
- 6. Test lock operation several times before closing the door.
- 7. If a mistake is made wait thirty (30) seconds and repeat steps 1 6.
  - Old Code will remain valid if a mistake is made.
  - In case of a mistake, display will show "CONFIRM CODE, NOT MATCH" and the old code will still be valid. Wait thirty seconds and repeat steps 1 - 6.

NOTE: IF THERE IS A LOCK SET TO AUTO OPEN - In a multiple lock system you can set an outer door lock to AUTO OPEN. This will allow the user (if authorized) to open the inner compartment lock and have the outer door lock automatically open. The AUTO OPEN lock always opens first.

# 2.0 OPENING LOCK

#### 2.1 OPENING THE LOCK (WITH FINGER ONLY ACCESS WITHOUT TIME DELAY)

- 1. Press any key to power up SMARTPOINT.
  - Display will show either "ENTER CODE" or "SELECT LOCK" when two or more locks are installed.
- 2. Select lock if two or more locks are installed; display will show "P TO SCAN, OK FOR CODE"
- 3. Press P key, display will show "SCAN YOUR FINGER"
  - If a valid fingerprint is entered, display will show "LOCK = 1, OPEN!"
  - If Lock is set with Open Offset, the display will show "LOCK = #, OFFSET = ##", and will show the counting sequence to the Offset.
- 4. Open the Door within 3 seconds.
  - · After doors re-lock, display will show current date and time.
  - If an invalid fingerprint is scanned or the finger was not placed directly on the scanner, the display will show "FINGERPRINT ERROR!"
  - Display will power-off after 30 seconds of non-operation.

NOTE: IF THERE IS A LOCK SET TO AUTO OPEN - In a multiple lock system you can set an outer door lock to AUTO OPEN. This will allow the user (if authorized) to open the inner compartment lock and have the outer door lock automatically open. The AUTO OPEN lock always opens first.

CAUTION: If there is a user whose fingerprint is unable to be read, by pressing OK they can enter their code and scan their print. The system will do a one-to-one match.

## 2.2 OPENING THE LOCK (WITHOUT TIME DELAY)

- 1. Press any key to power up SMARTPOINT.
  - Display will show either "ENTER CODE" or "SELECT LOCK" when two or more locks are installed.
- 2. Select lock if two or more locks are installed.
- 3. Enter a valid 6 (six) digit Manager Code (and scan finger, if set up)
  - If a valid code/finger is entered, display will show "LOCK = 1, OPEN!"
  - If Lock is set with Open Offset, the display will show "LOCK = #, OFFSET = ##", and will show the counting sequence to the Offset.
- 4. Open the Door within 3 seconds.
  - After doors re-lock, display will show current date and time.
  - If an invalid code is entered, display will show "NOT VALID USER!"
  - If an invalid fingerprint is scanned or the finger was not placed directly on the scanner, the display will show "FINGERPRINT ERROR!"
  - Display will power-off after 30 seconds of non-operation.

  - Display will show either "ENTER CODE" or "SELECT LOCK" when two, or more, locks are installed.
- 2. Select lock if two or more locks are installed.
- 3. Enter a valid 6 (six) digit Manager Code (and scan finger, if set-up)
  - If Time Delay has been set, display will show "STARTING, TIME DELAY" and then "LOCK = #, DELAY MM:SS"
  - The downward count is updated every second.
  - Press "P" to abort Time Delay; display will show "CANCEL, TIME DELAY?" Press OK; display will show "TIME DELAY, CANCELLED"
  - After Time Delay has elapsed, the display will show "#X MM:SS, x-x-x-x-x" (open window counting time).
- 4. During the open window, enter a valid code (and scan finger, if set up) to open.
  - If a valid code is entered, display will show "LOCK = 1, OPEN!"
- 5. Open the Door within 3 seconds.
  - After doors re-lock, display will show current date and time.
  - If and invalid code is entered, display will show "NOT VALID USER!"
  - If an invalid fingerprint is scanned or the finger was not placed directly on the scanner, the display will show "FINGERPRINT ERROR!"
  - Display will power-off after 30 seconds of non-operation.
  - If using the Time Delay Override, enter USER code and touch finger, if set up.

NOTE: During the Open Window the unit will beep 2 times every 10 seconds.

## 2.4 OPENING THE LOCK (WITH DUAL CODE - NO TIME DELAY)

- 1. Press any key to power up SMARTPOINT.
  - Display will show either "ENTER CODE" or "SELECT LOCK" when two or more locks are installed.
- 2. Select lock if two or more locks are installed, display will show "ENTER CODE, X-X-X-X-X-X"
- 3. Enter a valid 6 (six) digit Manager Code (and scan finger, if set up), display will show "2nd CODE, X-X-X-X-X"
- 4. Enter a 2nd valid 6 (six) digit code (and scan finger, if set up)
  - If a valid code is entered the LCD will display "LOCK = 1, OPEN!"
- 5. Open the Door within 3 seconds.
  - Before power-off, LCD will show current date and time.
  - Invalid code will prompt LCD to display "NOT VALID USER"
  - If an invalid fingerprint is scanned or the finger was not placed directly on the scanner, the display will show "FINGERPRINT ERROR!".
  - Display will power-off after 30 seconds of non-operation.

- 1. Press any key to power up SMARTPOINT.
  - Display will show either "ENTER CODE" or "SELECT LOCK" when two or more locks are installed.
- 2. Select lock if two or more locks are installed.
- 3. Enter a valid 6 (six) digit Manager Code (and scan finger, if set up)
  - If Time Delay has been set, display will show "STARTING, TIME DELAY" and then "LOCK = #, DELAY MM:SS"
  - · The downward count is updated every second.
  - Press "P" to abort Time Delay, display will show "CANCEL, TIME DELAY?" Press OK, display will show "TIME DELAY. CANCELLED"
  - After Time Delay has elapsed, the display will show "#X MM:SS, x-x-x-x-x" (open window counting time).
- - If a valid code is entered, display will show "2ND CODE, X-X-X-X-X"
- 5. Enter any valid code, display will show "LOCK = 1, OPEN!"
- 6. Open the Door within 3 seconds.
  - After doors re-lock, display will show current date and time.
  - If an invalid code is entered, display will show "NOT VALID USER!"
  - If an invalid fingerprint is scanned or the finger was not placed directly on the scanner, the display will show "FINGERPRINT ERROR!"
  - Display will power-off after 30 seconds of non-operation.

#### MANAGER MENU

#### Manager Menu allows to access to following functions:

- Set Time and Date
- View Audit
- PC Link
- System Set-up (assign locks to time lock setting, set system operation mode, set user access limit)
- User Management (add, delete, disable/enable, set lock access, add/delete time delay override, re-enroll fingerprints, set duress)
- General Manager (User #2) has the ability to add/delete other managers
- Set-up Time Delay, if enabled
- Open Offset

#### 3.1 MANAGER MENU ACCESS

- 1. Press any key to power up SMARTPOINT.
  - Display will show either "ENTER CODE" or "SELECT LOCK" when two or more locks are installed.
- 2. Hold down OK button; display will show "MANAGER, MENU ACCESS" then "MANAGER CODE, X-X-X-X-X-X" 3. Enter Manager Code (and scan finger, if set up).

NOTE: The first time the Manager accesses the Manager Menu, the system will prompt the user to change the Manager code.

- System Operation Mode (User Code Only [System Default], Dual User Code, Fingerprint Only, Fingerprint plus User Code, Fingerprint plus Dual Code, Dual Fingerprint plus Dual Code)
- · Access Limit (Ability to delete user automatically based on number of days assigned)
- System Information (Shows firmware version set in Logic Module)

NOTE: IF THERE IS A LOCK SET TO AUTO OPEN - In a multiple lock system you can set an outer door lock to AUTO OPEN. This will allow the user (if authorized) to open the inner compartment lock and have the outer door lock automatically open. The AUTO OPEN lock always opens first.

#### 3.5.1 SYSTEM SET-UP - Assign Lock (Assign Time Lock Set-up to a Lock)

- 1. Access the MANAGER MENU by following the instructions in section 3.1.
- 2. Press P three (3) times to select the next function; the display will show "SYSTEM SETUP"

#### 3.5.3 SYSTEM SET-UP - Access Limit

Ability to disable users automatically based on assigned number of days user's code has not been entered. Follow the four (4) steps for system set-up.

- 1. Access the MANAGER MENU by following the instructions in section 3.1.
  - If a valid code is entered the display will show "TIME/DATE"
- 2. Press P three (3) times to select the next function; the display will show "SYSTEM SETUP"
- 3. Press OK to select this function; display will show "ASSIGN LOCK"
- 4. Press P two (2) times; display will show "ACCESS LIMIT"
- 5. Press OK to enter the Menu; the display will show "ACCESS LIMIT DAYS = 0"
- 6. Enter the number of days (from 1 to 99) of no usage before a User is disabled from the system; display will show "ACCESS LIMIT" once last number is entered.
  - Must be entered as a two digit number, i.e., 02.
- 7. Press P to escape from menu.

# 3.6 USER MENU

#### 3.6.1 MANAGER MENU - USER - Add User

- 1. Access the MANAGER MENU by following the instructions in section 3.1.
  - If a valid code is entered the display will show "TIME/DATE"
- 2. Press P four (4) times to select the User Menu; the display will show "USERS ON/OFF?"
- 3. Press OK to view the User status: the display will show "USERS ON/OFF. (XX XX)"
- 4. Press 02 to 99 to enroll a user; display will show "USER ID = X, INSTALL?"
  - Depending on how the Logic Module was set up, only the amount of users available on the system will appear.
- 5. Press OK to install USER; the display will show "NEW CODE, X-X-X-X-X"
- 6. Enter a new six (6) digit code; display will show "CONFIRM NEW, X-X-X-X-X-X"
- 7. Enter new six (6) digit code a second time to confirm; display will show "ACCESS LOCK, -----"
- 8. Enter the Lock ID number for each lock that the User will have access to and press OK; display will show "FINGERPRINT NUMBER = 1"
- 9. Place finger on the reader and unit will beep once and begin scan. Unit will beep again and the display will show "2nd SCANNING" then "3rd SCANNING". Once scanning is completed, the display will show "ANOTHER FINGER"
  - The system offers the option of scanning up to three (3) fingers for each User or the Manager.
- For optimal results, finger should be lifted after each scan and then quickly replaced so that three separate captures are made.
- · Repeat this procedure for each fingerprint to be enrolled for this User. The system will only ask for the number of fingerprints as set up

during Logic Module setup.

- 10. Press OK to confirm and enroll another Fingerprint or P to exit; display will show "USER IS, MANAGER?"
- 11. Press OK to accept or P to bypass; display will show, "TIME DELAY, OVERRIDE"
- 12. Press OK to accept or P to bypass; display will show, "USER = X, INSTALLED!"

NOTE: If fingerprint enrollment fails, either because the finger was not placed on the scanner fully, thereby not allowing enough information to be collected, or because the finger was either too dry or too wet for scanning, the display will show "FINGERPRINT ENROLL FAIL" and then "TRY AGAIN?" Press OK to attempt fingerprint enroll again.

#### 6.0 BACK-UP BATTERY INSTALL/CHANGE OUT PROCEDURE

- 1. Remove black plastic battery compartment cover (located at the bottom of the keypad) by gently pulling downward on its handle.
- 2. Allow the battery and its attached leads to drop down and out of the battery compartment. If it does not drop, gently pull on the battery until it does.
- 3. Remove the connector by unsnapping it from the two terminals on the top of the battery.


- 4. Connect a new, high quality Energizer e2 Titanium or Duracell Ultra 9-Volt Alkaline battery to the battery clip.
- 5. Push the battery and the leads completely up into the battery compartment.
- 6. Install the battery cover by placing one side of the cover in position and then pressing the other side into position with your finger.

# **VIEWABLE AUDIT CODES**

When viewing the Audit on the LCD, the following is a list of code descriptions.

- U: User number, where 0 is the Master 0 and 1 is the Master 1. All other numbers correspond to the appropriate user 02 through 99.
- Lock number where 0 is the Logic Module. All other numbers correspond to the locks enrolled in the system.
- The code number for the event. See list below for a reference.

U 255 REFERS TO ANY OPERATION PERFORMED BY THE LOGIC MODULE. I.E. TIME DELAY SUSPEND, POWER UP AND BATTERY LOW.
