

## **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Determine unit type supplied (S) STOP ONLY or (H) STOP & HOLD.
- Determine degree of hold-open or dead stop required and select the "A", "B", "C", "D", "E" and "F" dimensions from the opposite side of this page.
- 3. Prepare door and frame according to the template found on this page.
- 4. Insert end blocks into each end of track. Install track and arm assembly to door, making sure spring faces hinges.
- 5. Attach soffit plate to frame.

## ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS (HOLD-OPEN UNITS):

- 6. Adjust hold-open to on or off position. One direction on-opposite direction off.
- Adjust the holding force by inserting a 5/64"
  hex key into the slide shoe bolt. Turn right to increase and left to
  decrease holding force.
- 8. Open door until slide shoe engages with hold-open.
- 9. To release the door, pull until the slide shoe disengages.
